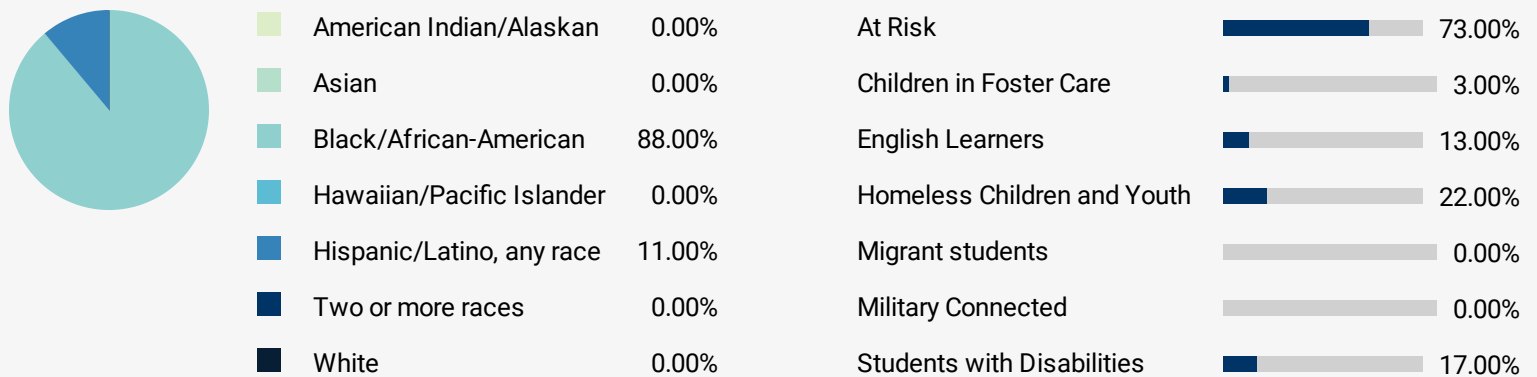
Message from the School
