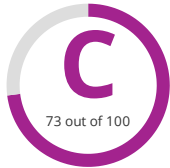

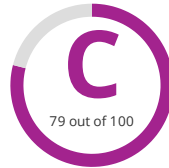
STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT



Student Achievement shows how much students know and are able to do at the end of the school year.



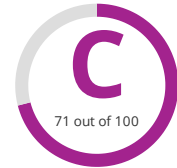
SCHOOL PROGRESS
